

Adopt-A-Flowerbed Contest Rules

For May- September

1. Volunteer(s) need to call Lee (208)612-8316 or Hannah (208)612-8391 to receive an information packet and choose a flowerbed that has been designated to be adopted. The volunteer(s) need to sign a contract of commitment and set up a day when they will be planting their beds:
 - a. Cemeteries needed be planted by Memorial Day weekend
 - b. All other beds must be planted between Memorial Day and the end of June.
2. Pick up flowers at the Maxine Elliot Greenhouse in Rose Hill Cemetery or arrange for delivery to the site. Each flowerbed has had equally beautiful and healthy flowers set aside for you to create your design. There will always be someone in the greenhouse to help you find and load your flowers, and to answer any questions that you may have.
3. Keep flowerbed(s) weeded, deadheaded and free of litter for the summer season. (June-September)
4. Please check your flowerbeds once a week.
5. The City will fertilize flowerbeds weekly or more as needed. The City will apply pesticide as needed.
