CV-CDBG Funds provided \$5 billion for CDBG COVID 19 grants:

### **CARES Act funds and how they apply to the City of Idaho Falls**

As an entitlement city, the first round of CARES Act CV1-CDBG funds (\$250,072) was allocated to the City of Idaho Falls in April of 2020. Funds were made available (by application) to community partners, agencies, and organizations to help them assist low- and moderate-income individuals and families, including elderly and disabled persons, affected by COVID 19. Applications supported activities that prepared, prevented, and responded to coronavirus. The second round of CARES Act CV2-CDBG funds (\$257,585) was allocated to the City of Idaho Falls in October of 2020.

**CV-CDBG/1** - \$2 billion for FY2020 formula (April 2)

**City received \$250,072.**

**CV-CDBG/2** - \$1 billion for new formula for states/insular areas (May 1). Reserved for States. States had the option to allocate to entitlement cities based on needs such as: LMI children/poor health or economic distribution based on unemployment claims data.

**CV-CDBG/3** - \$2 billion for new formula on a rolling basis and needs (May 11) DC received allocation to ensure complete national coverage.
